A student must apply on a Don E. Beattie Scholarship Application provided by the South Florida Section of the PGA of America. Applications are available online at www.sfpga.com.

ELIGIBILITY: High school seniors or college students enrolled in the freshmen or sophomore classes of undergraduate studies who are currently employed in the golf industry, or whose parents or grandparents are employed in or retired from the golf industry (PGA professionals, superintendents, sales representatives, club employees, or club managers, etc.). Applicants must be permanent residents of Palm Beach County, Florida.

Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 (based on a 4.0 scale). Application must include a letter of recommendation from a PGA professional or club manager. Students are not eligible to receive multiple SFPGA Charitable Foundation based scholarships during the same calendar year.

Only the award winners will be contacted, and results will be posted on our website.
