The Southeast Chapter of the South Florida PGA is awarding a select few juniors an opportunity to participate in proven local junior programs. Our goal is to introduce them to the great game of golf through junior golf classes or camps that have a fun and creative learning environment. We strive to highlight the relationship between the game of golf and each individual's personal development. Specifically, golf offers the opportunity to teach lessons in integrity, honesty and sportsmanship, as well as to learn about tradition and honoring the rules of the game. We believe that a good golf game starts with a positive learning experience under the guidance of experienced teaching professionals. Junior Golf Class or Camp instruction includes drivers and woods, long and short irons, sand and pitching wedges, and putting. Children, depending on their golf ability, will also learn shot and club selection, strategy, mental toughness and course etiquette.

**The SECSFPGA will award scholarships to juniors in need of financial assistance to the schools directly involved in this initiative. The SECSFPGA will work closely with scholarship recipients on the scheduling with the participating golf schools.**

*This packet contains information on the SECSFPGA Junior Class and/or Camp Scholarship. Applicants and parents should read the entire document before filling out the application. Below are a few key reminders:*

- SECSFPGA scholarship applicant must fill out application in its entirety to be eligible
- Household income less than \$65,000 (must include first two pages of your most recent 1040 tax return – additional factors may be considered)
- Applicants **MUST** also fill out liability waiver in its entirety to be eligible
- The deadline for submitting the scholarship application is June 1st, annually, to the SECSFPGA

**ELIGIBILITY:** Applicants must be between the ages of 5 and 17 at the time of the SECSFPGA sponsored Junior Golf Classes or Camps. Applicants must be permanent residents of the State of Florida. This scholarship is for juniors that are *in need of financial assistance* who could not otherwise attend the SECSFPGA Junior Golf Classes or Camps (families' total yearly income must be less than \$65,000 – must include first two pages of your most recent 1040 tax return). A great attitude is also a must! Students will be evaluated by facility instructors on a session by session basis. A low recommendation will result in early termination of said junior golfer's scholarship.
