

PACE OF PLAY POLICY & PROCEDURE

A standard rate of time 13 minutes and 20 seconds/hole for groups of 3 (4:00/round) and 15 minutes/hole for groups of four (4:30/round) will be set to play all SW Florida Chapter PGA Assistants' Group tournaments.

Lead groups will be considered out of position at any time when they exceed the standard rate of play. All additional groups will be considered out of position when falling at least one hole behind the group immediately in front of them or, while at the same time exceeding the standard rate of play. The previous statement is true throughout the round including when the group ahead finished in relation to the group in question.

The Committee will be working with both the Host Professional and his staff to monitor turn times and ensure that play is being completed at an acceptable pace.

Individuals are automatically “on the clock” when they tee off. It is the responsibility of each player in a group to know when they are behind and out of position.
