

WEATHER DELAY/CANCELLATION POLICY & PROCEDURE

It shall be the following weather (lightning) policy for the SW Chapter PGA Assistants' Group that guides and governs all sponsored tournaments. In regards to lightning and/or dangerous situation, the current policy of the host facility shall be the ultimate guide as to the continuation and/or completion of play. At anytime, a player feels threatened due to a dangerous situation; it is his or hers right , provided under the Rules of Golf by the United States Golf Association, to discontinue play and seek proper shelter.

A maximum of 90 minutes will constitute an official delay of play. If the entire field has not completed the same nine holes and the 90 minute delay has occurred, then the event shall be canceled. Every attempt to reschedule will be made based on host facility's (or substitute facility's) availability and Section, Chapter and Assistants' Group tournament schedules. If the Assistants' Group Committee decides that it is not feasible to complete 18 holes, and the entire field has completed the same nine holes and the 90 minute delay has occurred, then the event shall be deemed official and results will be based on the nine hole scores.

Players choosing to discontinue during a weather delay must notify the Committee and/or the host facility. Players exercising the above action will not be subject to any disciplinary action. The decision of the Assistants' Group Chairperson, Committee and host professional shall be final.
